

Concept:

Defining values for an Urban Legacy

- 1. Domain: Needs to be a hierarchy of public space for the larger good of people
- 2. Access: Fundamental Importance to be given to pedestrian movement & interaction versus vehicles
- 3. Diversity: In aesthetics, faith, social programs and housing typology to be addressed in policy documents and code
- 4. Shift in human perception of motility: Dwelling in neighbourhoods where walking is enjoyed consistently average higher


- 5. Humanity: In planning, in consumption of natural resources, in sustaining infrastructure
